Beautiful bedrooms...



The hotel has 22 individually furnished bedrooms, offering a wonderful dilemma of décor, size and ambiance from which to choose.

12 rooms are located in the 17th Century main building, all having a traditional Cotswold feel, with exposed stone walls and beams. Here the rooms range in size from small and cozy, to a large family room at the top of the hotel. We also have a four poster room, which, with its free-standing roll top bath large enough for two, adds that touch of magic to any romantic getaway.

To the rear of the hotel there are 4 Rafters Rooms, styled with pale pastels and contemporary furnishings, and 6 spacious and luxurious Garden Rooms. All of these rooms benefit from a quiet, tranquil location.

All rooms are en-suite, and have a writing desk, TV, radio, direct dial telephone with modem point, hair dryer and free wireless internet access. Some rooms also have mini bars and trouser presses.

The Conservatory Restaurant is the hotel's AA rosette awarded, fine dining restaurant. Providing possibly one of the most romantic settings in the Cotswolds, here guests dine by candle and fairy light, beneath the hotel's famous, century old Black Hamburg grapevine.

The menu is an enticing blend of modern and traditional French and English cooking, offering an extensive choice of dishes, to suit the most discerning tastes.

With a thoughtful, carefully selected wine list, and award winning, attentive service, we hope to make dining at the Conservatory an unforgettable experience.

Literally Italian for "the Grapevine", La Vigna, the hotel's brasserie, uses the same talented chefs and fresh ingredients as in the Conservatory Restaurant, but offers a less formal dining experience.

La Vigna provides an extensive range of the finest bistro dishes from Spain, Italy and Greece. We have also included some classic British bistro dishes to suit every taste. This exciting mix of pizza, pasta, meze, tapas and traditional favourites, has proved extremely popular with hotel residents and non-residents alike.

Our objective is to create the perfect environment for the bride and groom to relax, and enjoy the most important day of their lives.

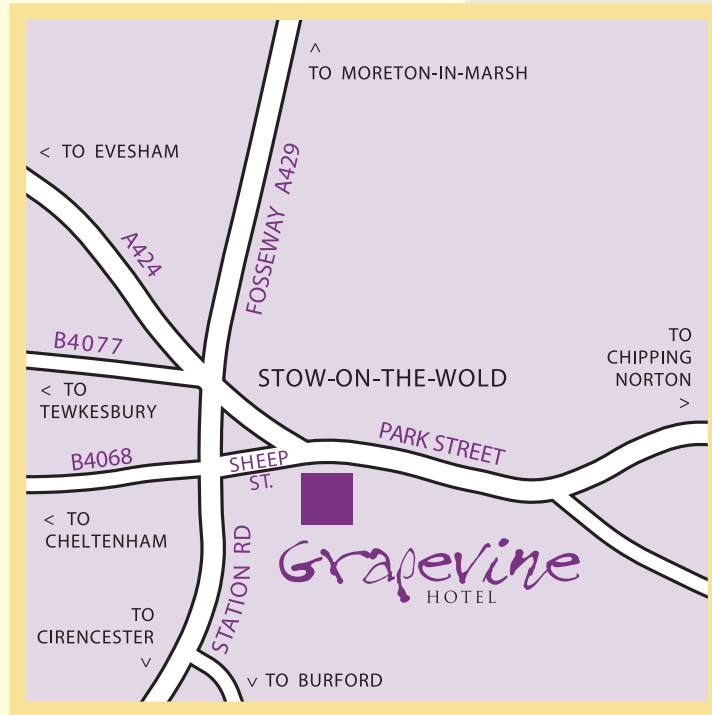
